Miniature Golf Schedule 1 / Check Box When Done

Select 1 putter.



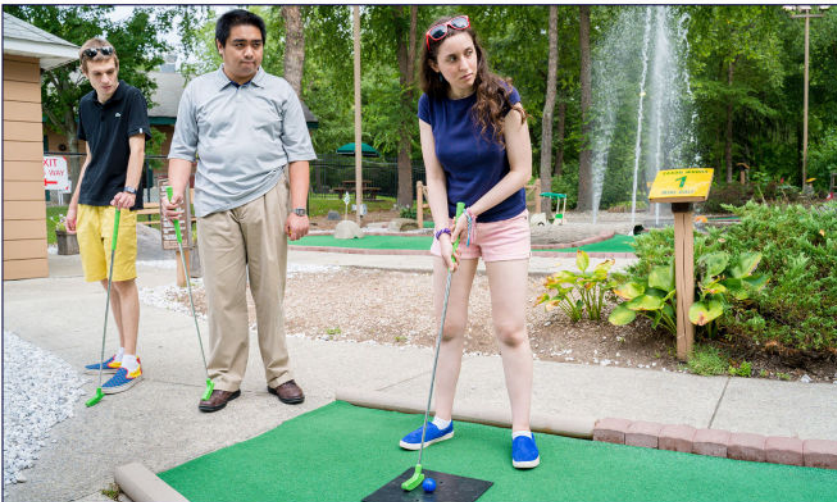
Miniature Golf Schedule 2 / Check Box When Done



Select 1 ball.



Place ball on tee at 1st hole.



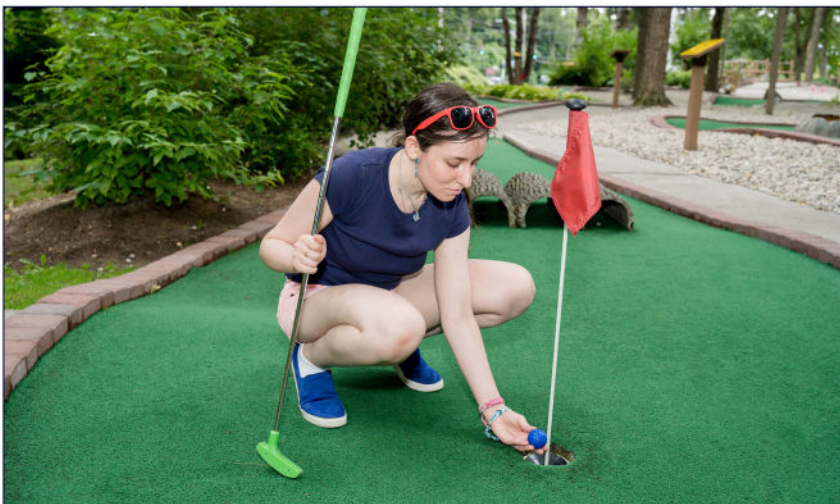
Hit the ball towards the hole.



Miniature Golf Schedule 3 / Check Box When Done



- Everyone takes turns hitting their ball until each gets their ball into the hole.



- Pick up ball from the hole.



- Write the number of times each person hit the ball.



Miniature Golf Schedule 4 / Check Box When Done



Repeat at each hole.



Once you've completed the final hole, you will lose your ball in the hole.



Return your putter to the counter.

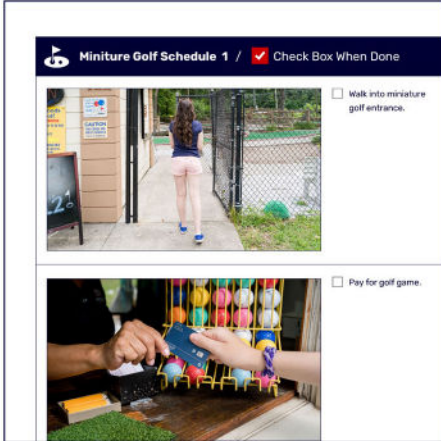

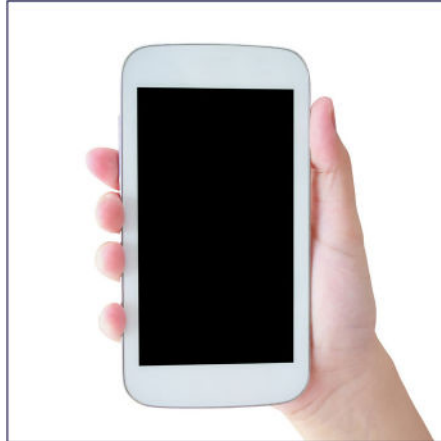

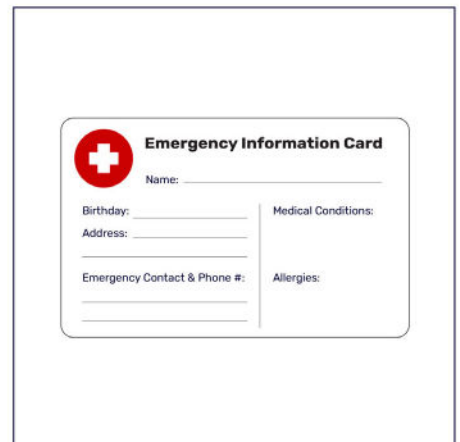

RULES Miniature Golf

Keep putter head close to the ground.



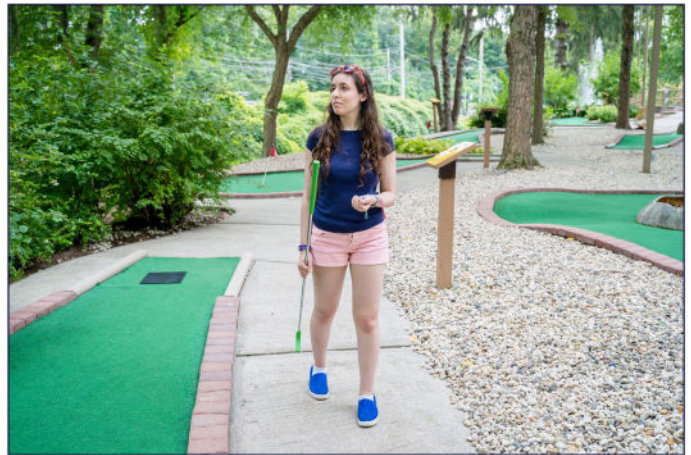
Wait your turn.



One person hits their ball at a time.



Walk on the path.



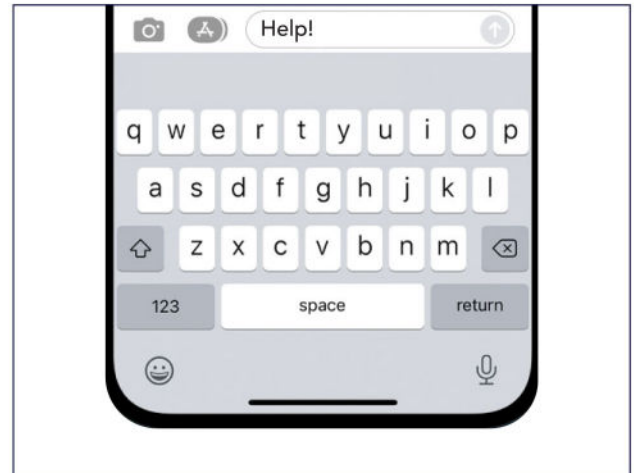
Follow instructions on all posted signs.



IF/THEN SCENARIOS

IF I get hurt and need help ...

THEN I stay where I am and wait.
Text 'help' to staff.



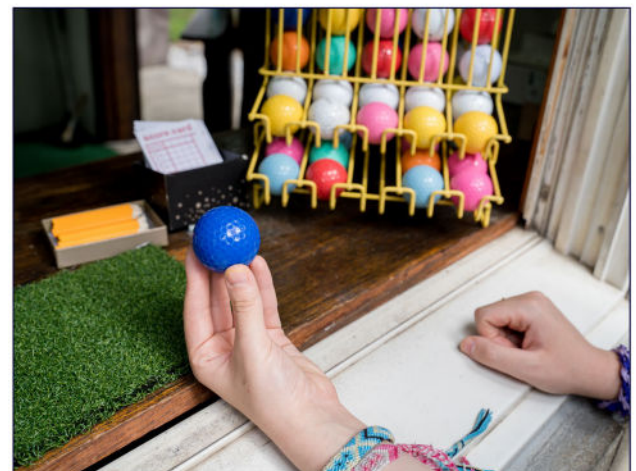
IF I get hot ...

THEN I drink some water.



IF I lose my golf ball ...

THEN I go to the person at the counter and ask for another ball **OR** I borrow a friend's ball and take turns playing.



IF/THEN SCENARIOS

IF there are too many people at the hole ...

THEN I wait for the others to finish the hole.



IF my ball doesn't go in the hole after 10 tries ...

THEN I pick up my ball and move to the next hole.



IF my friend makes a great shot ...

THEN I cheer for them.
